Specimen preservation is a process of preserving plants or animals in their best possible condition after death. This lost art of biology should be restored to create interest in students in their subject. Trained students can build the resources for the scientific description and identification of animal species in a zoological museum. Species are preserved by dry or wet conditions. Taxidermy is a way of preparing by stuffing or mounting the whole body or skin of an animal. Sometimes immersing the whole body in wet preservatives or only bone is stained to examine their skeletal structure.
