About the college

Egra Sarada Shashi Bhusan College (NAAC Accredited, CGPA of 2.23, "B" Grade) started its journey on August 8th, 1968, located at the south- end of the state of West Bengal, under the grace of some education lovers of the locality led by Prof. Dulal Chandra Das, who was the founder principal of the college. Initially, the college was affiliated to Calcutta University and started with two sections: Arts with Commerce with Honours. After Mr. Dulal Chandra Das, Shri Jyotirindra Nath Kar took the helm of the college from the Chair of Teacher-In-Charge, and during his tenure, honours courses in Bengali, English, and History were introduced. After the tenure of Shri Jyotirindra Nath Kar came to an end in 2001, Dr. Dipak Kumar Tamili was appointed as the Principal of the college. During his tenure, Honours courses in eleven more subjects, i.e. Mathematics, Philosophy, Accountancy, Botany, Physics, Geography, Zoology, Chemistry, Nutrition, Computer Science, B.Voc. and P.G. in Bengal, and Zoology, were introduced. Many certificate courses have been introduced by various departments in our college. It was through his efforts that the scope of studies in the college was expanded by adding Netaji Subhash Open University and **Bharati University** Rabindra (Distance Education) to the college. In addition to this, the college includes both indoor and outdoor stadiums where students can participate in a variety of sporting activities. A Research Centre has been established at our college (Coastal **Environmental Studies**) under Vidyasagar University, where 28 confide scholars' are registered under different departments.

About the seminar

Since prehistory, literature and the arts have been drawn to portrayals of physical and human-environment environments interactions.
