Report

The faculty assured that regular assessments would be conducted and communicated effectively to both students and parents, ensuring transparency in evaluation.
4. **Support for Mental Health:** Recognizing the psychological impact of the pandemic, parents requested additional support for students' mental health. Dr. Yadav mentioned the availability of counseling services and encouraged parents to utilize these resources to help their children navigate these challenging times.


Suggestions from Parents


